KEEPING HIGH-QUALITY CARE AFFORDABLE

Blue PerformanceSM providers are placed into tiers based on cost of care. All providers in Tier 1 and Tier 2 are in network. However, choosing a provider in Tier 1 offers opportunity for greater savings.

Hospitals and physicians within the same care system are in the same tier. Emergency care is paid at Tier 1 benefit level, regardless of the facility's assigned tier.

- **Tier 1:** Highest benefit, lowest out-of-pocket cost
- **Tier 2:** Lower benefit, higher out-of-pocket cost
- **Out of network (OON):** Lowest benefit, highest out-of-pocket cost

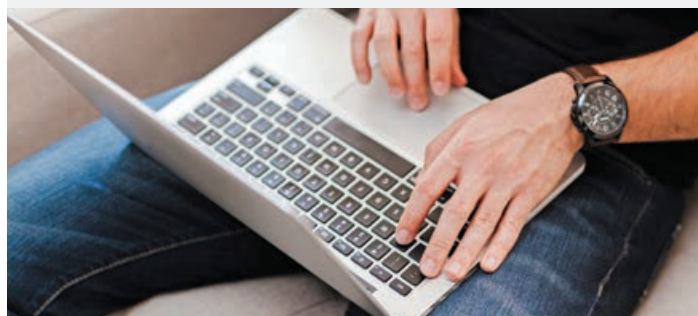

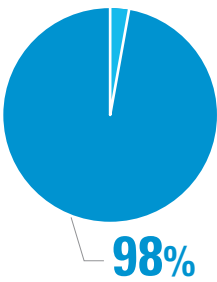
